

Brookside Tournament Rules

Matches will be played at Brookside where possible but due to the number of entrants people must be prepared to play on other courts e.g. School as the schedule is very tight.

Tournament format

- All players will be assigned a rating by the Tournament Committee from A to M.
- The handicap sheet will show the score to start each game based on each players rating.
- For same sex doubles, ratings of the two players are combined according to the table provided and then the handicap is determined using the combined rating.
- For mixed doubles pair is assigned a rating.
- Matches will be the best of 3 sets.
- No tie breaks will be played. At 6 games all the winner of the next game wins the set except in the 3rd set when two clear games are required.
- It is important that you start serving from the correct side of the court e.g. in a +30 : -15 match, serving would always start to the advantage court.
- It is the responsibility of the players to ensure that games are started at the correct 'score'. If it is discovered after a game is completed that the game was not scored correctly the score will stand and the game cannot be replayed.
