Additional Notes

1. In certain circumstances, e.g. because of illness, injury, work re-location or pregnancy, if the Club is notified it may be possible to freeze membership and transfer it to a future year. This transfer must be within 3 years. The fee due in the transfer year is then a pro rata of the membership fee for the months not covered by the transfer.
2. Any winner of a pair of tickets in a Club Ballot must be a current member (Adult or Junior 9 and over) and signed up to British Tennis Membership on the date that the Club Ballot takes place and a member at the time of purchase, and at the time of visiting the event.
3. All junior members must complete a junior membership form each year to provide up to date contact and medical details.
